**SUBJECT: Written examination for the grant of Airline Transport Pilot License - Aeroplanes**

1. In accordance with paragraph 3(1)(c) and paragraph 13 of the Eighth Schedule of the Air Navigation Regulation of Macao, a person applying for the grant of an Air Transport Pilot License – Aeroplanes (ATPLA) is required to pass a written examination.
2. The ATPLA written examinations **from July to December 2010** will be held as follows:

*Note: The examination is intended for Macau CPLA holder who wishes to apply for ATPLA only. Persons holding an ATPLA issued by other ICAO states should take the conversion examination.*

3. The ATPLA written examination is divided into two papers (see Table 1). Paper I consists of 4 sections and Paper II, 3 sections. Applicant must achieve at least 70% for each section except for Air Law which is 80%. If the applicant fails a paper, he/she needs to re-sit for the failed section of the paper only.
4. The examination syllabus and application form are available from the AACM Personnel Licensing Office.
5. Applicant needs to submit a completed application form together with the appropriate fee no later than 5 working days prior to the examination date.

6. Examinations start promptly at 9:30 am. Time firm, no exception.
7. A copy of the examination booking form with concerned examination schedule will be returned to the candidate when the booking is confirmed. All Candidates **are required to present this confirmed examination booking form with his/her valid personal identification document** on the examination day.
8. No refund of examination fee is possible where a confirmed booking for any examination is cancelled by the candidate at less than 5 working days prior to the examination date. Refund request must be made in writing to the AACM.
9. Examination results are assessed as either 'Pass' or 'Fail' and are normally published within 10 working days after the examination. Results are either dispatched by post or available for personal collection from AACM upon request. Examination results will not be disclosed over the telephone.

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
