SUBJECT: Examinations for the Application of MAR-66 Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licence

1. The purpose of this AIC is to provide an examination schedule and guidelines for the application of examinations for the MAR-66 Aircraft Maintenance Engineer Licence.
2. The subject examinations will be held according to the following schedule:

3. Application of examination shall be made to the AACM no later than 5 working days prior to the examination date, either by submitting via the Aeronautical License Management System (ALMS) online service platform (<https://licensing.aacm.gov.mo/alms-pub>) or by submitting the application form (PEL/APP/023, available on the AACM website: <https://www.aacm.gov.mo/>) to the AACM office in person (or by his/her delegate), with the examination fee paid according to the charging scheme regulation.
4. A photo ID or passport is required for the application. Upon confirmation of the booking, a Confirmation of the Examination Booking form will be provided to the applicant (or available for download from the ALMS if the application is made online). The applicant shall present the same photo ID or passport, along with the Confirmation of the Examination Booking form, to the AACM invigilator on the examination date.
5. All requests for changes to a confirmed examination date shall be made in person (or by his/her delegate) to the AACM office, in writing, at least 5 working days before the original examination date.
6. Examination results are assessed as either 'Pass' or 'Fail' and are typically published within 10 working days after the examination. Results will be available for personal collection from

the AACM (or dispatched by post upon request). Examination results will not be disclosed over the telephone or via email query.

7. All examinations will be delivered through the computer system, including both multi-choice and essay questions.
8. No reference material will be provided for any examinations.
9. Examinations for the B3 licence and conversion examinations for limitations removal are currently unavailable until further notice.
