Guidance Notes for Application for Permission for Transport of Munitions of War on board an aircraft

- Note 1: The completed form together with all supporting documents shall be submitted by post to the Civil Aviation Authority of Macao SAR, Alameda Dr. Carlos D'Assumpção, 336-342 Centro Comercial Cheng Feng, 18º andar, Macau; by email to aacm@aacm.gov.mo; or by fax to (853) 2833 8089. For enquiries, please call Tel. no.: (853) 28511213 / 8796 4167 / 8796 4175.
- Note 2: The approval process normally requires four weeks, but may require additional time depending on the circumstances and quality of the submission.
- Note 3: Application for permission to transport MOW for in areas other than the cabin compartment must include the following:
 - (a) The procedures adopted by the air operator to inform the pilot in command of the aircraft in writing before the flight commences of the type, weight or quantity and location of any such MOW on board the aircraft or suspended beneath the aircraft and any conditions of the permission of the AACM.
 - (b) The procedures adopted by the air operator to ensure that the MOW is stored in part of the aircraft that is inaccessible to passengers.
 - (c) The procedures adopted by the air operator to ensure that in case of a firearm, the weapon or MOW is unloaded and batteries removed.
 - (d) The procedures adopted by the air operator to ensure that ammunitions are transport according to ICAO dangerous goods regulations, such as securely packaged cartridges of ammunition classified as dangerous goods Division 1.4S (UN 0012 or UN 0014 only) are in quantities not more than 5 kg gross mass per person for that person's own use; and
 - (e) The procedures adopted by the air operator for handling over of weapons or MOW at the aerodrome of arrival.
- Note 4: Application for permission to transport law enforcement officer authorized to carry weapons must include the followings:
 - (a) The procedures adopted by the air operator to instruct the armed law enforcement officers on all rules and regulations on the carriage of weapons; and
 - (b) The procedures adopted by the air operator to inform the pilot in command of the aircraft in writing before the flight commences of the type, weight or quantity of any such weapons on board the aircraft, the number of armed law enforcement officer on board the aircraft, and their seat locations.
