Markings and placards

EFFECTIVE DATE:

01 June 2025

CANCELLATION:

This Aeronautical Circular (AC) supersedes AC No. AC/AW/034R01 dated 31 October 2023.

GENERAL:

The President of Civil Aviation Authority (AACM), in exercise of his power under article 35 of the Statutes of Civil Aviation Authority approved by the Decree-Law 10/91/M and paragraph 89 of the Air Navigation Regulation of Macao (ANRM), established this Aeronautical Circular.

1. Introduction

- 1.1. For the purpose of this AC, the terms placards and markings are used interchangeably.
- 1.2. According to paragraph 12 (5) of the ANRM, the position of emergency equipment shall be indicated by clear markings in or on the aircraft. Markings and placards are also installed in aircraft as means of ensuring that information prescribed in Scale B of the Fifth Schedule of the ANRM are conveyed to passengers. Moreover, placards are installed to provide information, reminders, instructions and warnings to passengers, aviation personnel and rescuers.
- 1.3. The purpose of this AC is to establish requirements to standardise placards and ensure proper usage and control of the Chinese translations in bilingual placards, aimed at minimising the confusion caused to passengers, aviation personnel and rescuers.

2. Applicability

- 2.1. This AC is applicable to aircraft registered in Macao.
- 2.2. The following are not affected by this AC:
 - (a) Nationality and registration marks, which shall comply with the requirements prescribed in paragraph 5 and Part B of the First Schedule of the ANRM;

- (b) Exit and breaking-in markings of commercial air transport aircraft, which shall comply with the requirements prescribed in paragraph 43 of the ANRM;
- (c) Marking of break-in points of aeroplane flying for purpose other than commercial air transport or aerial work, which shall comply with the requirements prescribed in paragraph 115 of the ANRM;
- (d) Marking of break-in points of helicopter flying for purpose other than commercial air transport or aerial work, which shall comply with the requirements prescribed in paragraph 175 of the ANRM.

3. Definition

Bilingual placard means placard which utilises English narrative with Chinese translation.

Pictorial placard means placard which utilises pictogram or symbol representing a concept, object, activity, place or event by illustration.

4. General requirements

4.1. All placards shall possess the following characteristics:

- (a) be legible;
- (b) be easy to understand;
- (c) be located in an obvious place and clearly visible;
- (d) not be easily erased, removed, disfigured, or obscured; and
- (e) have adequate colour contrast to background.

4.2. Placards for Emergency Equipment

4.2.1. Placards indicating emergency equipment shall be located approximately at eye level. For small aircraft which may not allow placards to be located at eye level, the placards shall be located at a conspicuous location as practicable. If the emergency equipment is located in an upper or lower compartment, the eye level placard should have an arrow indicating the compartment.

4.2.2. Each compartment containing emergency equipment such as life preservers, rafts, slides, slide/rafts, or fire extinguishers shall be placarded as to its contents.

4.2.3. For placards indicating emergency equipment, a colour contrast that complies with the specification prescribed in CS/FAR 25.811 (f) (2) is acceptable.

4.3. Placards that convey a written warning, instruction or information to passengers shall:

- (a) utilise imperative words or sentences and English narrative with Chinese translation; or
- (b) utilise purely pictogram or symbol.

Note 1: Placards intended for exclusive use by cabin crew are not considered for passenger use if the aircraft is required to carry cabin crew by paragraph 18 (8) of the ANRM or by aircraft flight manual.

Note 2: Placards are considered for passenger use if the area may be left unattended by cabin crew. For example, the galley area may be left unattended by cabin crew in long haul flights. In this case, the placards for waste disposal in this area shall meet the requirements of this sub-paragraph.

- 4.4. When there is the need for replacing the placard during aircraft maintenance, the material of the new placard, the size and colour of the character, the background colour, etc. shall remain as per the same specification of the original placard.

Note: Installation of additional placards or alteration to placards installed in the aircraft is considered as modification. The applicable requirements of AC No. AC/AW/004 Airworthiness Procedure No. AP5 shall be complied with.

5. Bilingual placard

5.1. Principles of Chinese translation

- 5.1.1. For any English narrative, there shall only be one set of Chinese translation on each aircraft.
- 5.1.2. The Chinese translation consists of both words and punctuation marks.
- 5.1.3. Notwithstanding paragraph 5.1.1 above, there may be alternative translation(s) for any English narrative if the information to be conveyed is different than that previously translated due to the different design or application.
- 5.1.4. There is no alternatives to the Chinese words “出口”, “緊急出口”, “緊急情況時在此破開”, and “此門不通” prescribed in paragraph 43 of ANRM.
- 5.1.5. For bilingual placards installed in an aircraft for which the individual certificate of airworthiness is first issued in Macao on or after 01 January 2022, or for which modification affecting bilingual placards is embodied on or after 01 January 2022, only Chinese translations listed in Appendix 1 of this AC shall be used.
- 5.1.6. Proposal on new Chinese translation shall be made in writing to the President of the AACM for acceptance. Once accepted, the new translation will be added to Appendix 1 of this AC.

5.2. Presentation of Chinese translation

- 5.2.1. The English narrative and Chinese translation shall be displayed:

- (a) on the same placard; or

(b) on separated placards installed adjacently.

5.2.2. Chinese words may be presented in either traditional characters (繁體字) or simplified characters (简体字).

5.2.3. For placards that convey a written warning, instruction or information to passengers as required by paragraph 4.3 (a) above, mixed types of Chinese traditional characters and simplified characters shall not be utilised in the same aircraft.

5.2.4. For bilingual placards installed in an aircraft for which the individual certificate of airworthiness is first issued in Macao on or after 01 January 2022, or for which modification affecting bilingual placards is embodied on or after 01 January 2022,

(a) Chinese characters on a bilingual placard or Chinese placard shall be in the same font type; and

Note: Some Chinese characters are displayed differently under different font types. There are no requirements on the specific font type to be used in bilingual placards.

(b) the height of Chinese characters shall be no less than that of the corresponding English letters. Except for a few Chinese characters which are inherently lower than that of the others such as “一”, “二”, “口”, the variable heights of Chinese characters in a bilingual placard or Chinese placard are acceptable provided that they are in the same font type and font size.

Note: For placard in English with both capital and lower cases, the height should be that of the capital letter.

5.3. Bilingual Placard List

5.3.1. The operator, or the registered owner of the aircraft as the case may be, shall maintain a current record of all bilingual placards in a Bilingual Placard List (BPL) for each aircraft.

5.3.2. The BPL shall include all bilingual placards which are installed:

- (a) as required by paragraph 4.3 (a) of this AC; and
- (b) anywhere on the aircraft optionally or voluntarily.

5.3.3. The BPL shall include at least the following information:

- (a) Aircraft effectivity by registration mark(s);
- (b) Revision number and publish date;
- (c) The English text and the corresponding Chinese text or picture(s) of the corresponding placards.

6. Pictograms and pictorial placards

6.1. Pictograms are used on placards to overcome the issue of persons not being able to read or understand the language of a textual sign, marking or placard which would result in them missing out on information that may be critical for the safety of flight or to prevent personal injury. The use of pictograms for signs, markings and placards promotes global comprehension of their meaning and helps surpass language barriers.

6.2. The following pictograms are acceptable to the AACM:

- (a) approved as part of the aircraft type design by the State of Design;
- (b) published in Civil Aviation Administration of China (CAAC) Advisory Circular no. AC-21-AA-2013-14R6 or any subsequent amendment; or
- (c) listed in Appendix 2 of this AC.

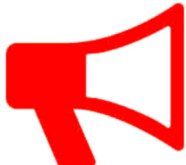
