SUBJECT: <u>Written examination for the grant of Flight Operations Officer (FOO) License</u>

- 1. In accordance with paragraphs 3 and 5 of the Fourth Schedule to the Air Navigation Regulation of Macao (ANRM), a person applying for the grant or conversion of a flight operations officer license is required to pass a written examination to ascertain his/her knowledge on the various subjects cited in paragraph 7 of the Fourth Schedule to the ANRM related to the exercise of the privileges of the applicant's license.
- 2. The examination conducted by the AACM is arranged as necessary. Applicant who wishes to apply for FOO written examination is required to:
 - a) submit the completed application form (PEL/APP/019) together with the appropriate fee;
 - b) submit a proof of employment from an operator of Macao registered aircraft for conducting commercial air transport operations;
 - c) submit documents certifying the successful completion of knowledge training of an approved operator-specific training course; and
 - d) submit copy of a valid flight operations officer license issued by an ICAO Contracting State (applicable to license conversion only).

Application form is available from the Civil Aviation Authority – Macao, China (AACM), Personnel Licensing Office and on the AACM website: <u>www.aacm.gov.mo</u>.

- 3. The FOO written examination is composed of <u>one</u> paper. To pass the examination, candidate must achieve at least 70% of the paper.
- 4. Examination starts promptly at 9:30 a.m.. Time firm, no exception.
- 5. A copy of the examination booking form with concerned examination schedule will be returned to the candidate when the booking is confirmed. All candidates **are required to present the confirmed examination booking form** <u>with</u> **his/her valid personal identification document** on the examination day.
- 6. Cancellation of a confirmed booking must be made in writing to the AACM at least 3 working days prior to the examination day.

- 7. Examination result is assessed as either 'Pass' or 'Fail' and is normally published within 5 working days after the examination. Result is either dispatched by post or available for personal collection from the AACM upon request. Examination result will not be disclosed over the telephone.
- 8. The written examination is based on a system of three attempt cycles. If a candidate fails in the examination paper, he/she will be allowed two further attempts to pass the paper with following conditions:
 - a) The second attempt will be at least 2 calendar weeks following the first attempt.
 - b) The third attempt will be at least 3 calendar weeks following the second attempt.
 - c) Whenever a candidate fails the third attempt, the next attempt will only be schedule 3 months following the third attempt, unless otherwise determined by the AACM.
