## **GENERAL:**

The President of Civil Aviation Authority, in exercise of his power under Paragraph 89 of the Air Navigation Regulation of Macao (ANRM) and Article 35 of the Statutes of Civil Aviation Authority, approved by the Decree-Law 10/91/M, established this Aeronautical Circular (AC), which defines the new rules regarding the issuance of Aeronautical Circulars.

## 1 Introduction

According to the above referred Article 35 of the Statutes of Civil Aviation Authority, approved by Decree-Law n. 10/91/M, the Civil Aviation Authority has the power to issue "Circulars" not only containing informative issues but also instructions with binding effect after notification to the receiver through registered mail or by any means that ensures that the receiver acknowledges the reception.

## 2 Amendments to the Air Navigation Regulation of Macao (ANRM)

In face of the above, and in accordance with Articles 2 and 3 of Executive Order nr. 25/2003, any amendment to the ANRM will be made through AC and notified to the relevant entities. Any amendment to the ANRM made through this new process will be incorporated in the next revision of the ANRM to be gazetted.

#### 3 Format

Any future Aeronautical Circular will be issued in accordance with the following format: **AC/XXX/yyyRzz**, of which:
