SUBJECT: New Format of the Medical Certificate

GENERAL:

The President of Civil Aviation Authority – Macao, China, in exercise of his power under Paragraph 89 of the Air Navigation Regulation of Macao (ANRM) and Article 35 of the Statutes of Civil Aviation Authority, approved by the Decree-Law 10/91/M, established this Aeronautical Circular (AC).

1 Introduction

In accordance with the Fourteenth Schedule to the ANRM, a person applying for the grant or renewal of a license to act either as member of the operating crew of an aircraft, or an air traffic controller is required to undergo medical examination to ascertain his / her health condition. Medical Certificate is issued if the medical condition of the applicant conforms to the standard of fitness.

As the medical provisions are updated as per AC/PEL/004R00, some of the contents of the Medical Certificate are modified. The modification of Medical Certificate is detailed in this AC.

2 Applicability

The modified Medical Certificate will be issued for the successful Medical Certificate renewal application with all the required medical examinations conducted on or after 1 November 2007.

3 Modification of Medical Certificate

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The data contained in the modified Medical Certificate is shown in Table 1. The back of the certificate contains information regarding the Medical Certificate for quick reference; the table of the explanation of the limitation codes, the table of the validity of the Medical Certificate, and the notes regarding the requirements of certificate holders which are extracted from the ANRM.

- 1. Class of Medical Certificate;
- 2. Full name of the certificate holder;
- 3. Date of birth of the certificate holder:
- 4. Address of the certificate holder;
- 5. Nationality of the certificate holder;
- 6. The date of the medical examination for the issue of the certificate:
- 7. The expiry date(s) of the Medical Certificate
- 8. The name of the Aviation Medical Examiner (AME) conducting the examination;
- 9. The due dates of special examination: normally include Audiogram, ECG; and any other examination specified by the AME;
- 10. The code of the limitation on the Medical Certificate, refer to the table on the back of the certificate;
- 11. The signature of the certificate holder;
- 12. The signature and stamp of the licensing authority; and
- 13. The unique serial number of the Medical Certificate.

4 Responsibilities of Medical Certificate holders

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The medical assessment towards the issue of Medical Certificate is composed of several examinations. Normally, the assessment includes medical specialists examinations, laboratory tests and special examinations mentioned in item 9 of Table 1.

The expiry dates of the special examinations described in item 9 of Table 1 are specified on the Medical Certificate. The certificate holder has the responsibility to make proper arrangement to ensure the required special examinations listed on the certificate are completed before their corresponding due dates. He shall inform the medical group if such examinations are due when he makes the appointment for the medical examination.

The certificate holder shall present the certificate to the AME during medical examination for certificate renewal.

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
